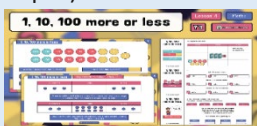

Maths-Place value

This term the children will be looking at number and place value. Children will be taught to recognise the place value of each digit in a three-digit number. (Hundreds, tens and ones). In addition, this term, they will be looking at statistics; bar charts, pictograms and tables as well as geometry (2-D shapes).



English

This term the children will be using a core text as a stimulus for writing. The texts 'Rama and Sita' will be shared through our class reading sessions, building on children's reading skills of inference, clarification, and retrieval. The books will also be used as a stimulus for writing a character description with a grammar focus on expanded noun phrases, coordinating conjunctions and a range of punctuation.

In this unit children will be looking at the following:

Science: Light



In this unit the children will recognise that they need light to see things and that darkness is the absence of light.

They will learn that shadows are formed when light from a light source is blocked by a solid object.

Computing



Children will develop their understanding of digital devices, with an initial focus on inputs, processes, and outputs. They also compare digital and non-digital devices. They will be introduced to computer networks,

Dance- This term for indoor PE, children will be able to show an imaginative response to the stimulus of 'space' in order to incorporate different qualities and dynamics into their movement.
