Art & Design	In Art this half-term we are focusing on portraits. The children will be shown a range of famous portraits and try to recreate them, including 'The Girl with the Pearl Earring'. They will also create portraits in styles of different artists, such as Picasso and Andy Warhol. The children will learn how to focus on distinguishing features of their own faces to create a self-portrait.
P.E.	In outdoor PE the children will be learning skills used in hitting and striking games, such as tennis, rounders and cricket. They will have the opportunity to use these skills in game situations and play as part of a team. In indoor PE Year 2 will be creating a sequence of dance moves in response to pieces of music, both independently and in groups. They will be encouraged to perform their dances to other children in the class.
Homework	Homework will be set weekly on a Friday and will be expected to be returned by the following Wednesday. Homework consists of English and Maths which is a consolidation of their learning in class. Children are expected to read out loud to an adult daily at home for at least 15 minutes and are observed reading independently in class. Children's reading books will be changed every Thursday. Please fill in the reading record and ensure this is returned with your child's library books.
