

Kingfisher Hall Learning Grid: Autumn Term 1, Year 6



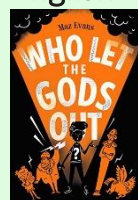
Force for positive change: Year 6 will be using their knowledge of government and politics to drive forward the school primary parliament. They will lead by example as role models for the rest of the school.

Maths



Children will begin with consolidating their knowledge of place value, up to numbers to 10 million. In addition, children will continue to learning different methods for the 4 operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, before looking at fractions.

English



In English, children will be reading *Who Let the Gods Out* by Maz Evans. The children will be using this text during their daily reading sessions as well as using this as a stimulus for writing. The writing genres that the children will be focussing on this term will be: Non-chronological report and Persuasive speeches.

History / Geography



Through our Humanities topic, the children will be learning all about where, when and why the Ancient Greek Empire spread and the influences it has had on the modern western world.

Science:



Children will recognise that light appears to travel in straight lines and they will use this idea to explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye. They will explain that we see things because light travels from light sources to our eyes or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes. Through a series of investigations, they will use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them.

PHSE: Being Me, My World



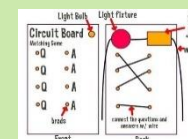
This term the children will be learning about other people's feelings and developing their own skills

Physical Education:



Outdoor: In PE this term, the children will be Net / wall games

DT



This term the children will design, make and evaluate their own electronic quiz games to spread their messages about food recycling. Children will use their knowledge of electrical circuits to design the boards which will be sold to raise money for their campaign.

Music



Children will be exploring music through a range of genres and instrumental families. They will be having a weekly music lesson that will focus on tempo, dynamics, crescendo and diminuendo. They will also be showing appreciation of musical styles and genres through our 'Music of the Day'

RE: Judaism

This term the children will be learning about key festivals of the Jewish faith, including: Rosh Hashanah; Yom Kippur and Shabbat.

Indoor: Our indoor PE this term will be gymnastics, focussing on the skills of balance and travel.

Children will continue to learn how to use Google Slides for their humanities presentations and Google Sheets to collate and analyse data. In addition, they will be consolidating their coding skills through a range of tasks on DB Primary.
