<u>Force for positive change:</u> Year 6 will be using their knowledge of government and politics to drive forward the school primary parliament. They will lead by example as role models for the rest of the school.

Maths



Children will begin with consolidating their knowledge of place value with numbers up to 10 million. In addition, children will continue to learn

different methods for the 4 operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, before looking at fractions.

English



In English, children will be reading *Who Let the Gods Out* by Maz Evans. The children will be using this text during their daily reading sessions as well as

using this as a stimulus for writing. The writing genres that the children will be focussing on this term will be non-chronological reports and diary entries.

History / Geography: Greeks & Government

The children

Ancient Greek Empire spread and the influences it has had on the modern western world.

Science: Electricity



Children will know what a circuit is and the components that make it. They will begin to understand voltage as the pressure from an electrical

circuit's power source that pushes (current) through a conducting loop, and associate the brightness of a lamp or the volume of a buzzer with the number and voltage of cells used in the circuit. Children will also learn the recognised symbols when representing a simple circuit in a diagram.

PHSE: Being Me, My World



This term the children will be learning about other people's feelings and developing their own skills.

Physical Education:

Outdoor: In PE this term, the children will be learning about and playing net and wall games

Indoor: Our indoor PE this term will be gymnastics, focusing on the skills of balance and travel.

DT: Electric Quiz Boards



This term the children will design, make and evaluate their own electronic quiz games.

Children will use their knowledge of electrical circuits to design and make the boards.

Spanish:The children will be starting their Spanish learning adventure by learning greetings, giving their name, counting to 20 and saying their age.

Music

In music, year 6 will be looking at the work of the composer Alan Menken on the *Hercules* film, exploring how he uses different musical elements to convey suspense, calm and conflict.

Computing: Web Page Creations

The children will be using Google Sheets to create web pages for all Primary Parliament candidates. This will include a "How to" page for the school website and home learning.



RE: Judaism

This term the children will be learning about key festivals of the Jewish faith, including: Rosh Hashanh; Yom Kippur and Shabbat.
