










Kingfisher Hall Learning Grid: Autumn Term 2, Year 3

<p> Maths Multiplication & Division</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Two digit numbers times one digit numbers - Missing number problems - Formal written methods - Write and calculate mathematical statements <p>Measurement: Money</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Addition and subtraction involving money <p>Geometry : 3d shapes.</p>	<p> English :</p> <p>This term, children will be writing a setting description and a non-chronological report based on the text, Stone Age Boy. Some of the grammar skills they will be using include; expanded noun phrases, present tense, adverbs of time, prepositions/ prepositional phrases.</p>	<p>History: Stone Age to Iron Age</p> <p> This term, the children will begin to look at the Stone Age, leading to the Iron Age. They will create a timeline and focus on Palaeolithic, Mesolithic and Neolithic and begin to look at the advancement of tools & inventions over time.</p>	<p>Science: Rocks</p> <p> This term the children will identify, learn about and compare different types of rocks and soils and their properties.</p>
<p>PHSE: Celebrating Differences</p> <p>Children will learn about families, that they are all different and that sometimes they fall out with each other. The children also talk about techniques to calm themselves down and discuss a technique called 'solve it together.' The children will also revisit the topic of bullying and talk about being a witness (bystander), they will talk about how a witness has choices and how these choices can affect the bullying that is taking place.</p>	<p>Physical Education </p> <p>Outdoor: Invasion games-passing and creating space</p> <p>In this unit children will be learning various ball games using a range of technique, which involves passing and throwing.</p> <p>Indoor: Gymnastics</p> <p>Children will develop their skills in travelling with a change of direction.</p>	<p>Collage</p> <p> The children will be learning about creating and evaluating their own collage inspired by Maïa Vysotska</p> <p>Spanish:</p> <p> This term, children will learn to say and understand numbers 11-31</p>	<p>Music</p> <p> Children will be exploring music through a range of genres and instrumental families. They will be having a weekly music lesson that will focus on tempo, dynamics, crescendo and diminuendo. They will also be showing appreciation of musical styles and genres through our 'Music of the Day'.</p> <p>Computing: Computer systems and network</p> <p> Children will learning about digital devices, connection and school networks.
