

Maths

Children will be exploring the following this term:

- Number Place Value, Fraction and Decimals
- Measurement conversion and time
- Statistics
- Children will continue to develop their problem-solving skills through investigations.



English:

In English, children will be reading How to Train your Dragon by Cressida Cowell. The children will be using this text during their daily reading sessions as well as using this as a stimulus for writing. The writing genres that

the children will be focussing on this term will be: poetry (vocabulary generation and developing a poem), fiction (journey story) and fact files on different types of dragons.

Science: Living things & their habitats: classification, environmental changes



In science, children will explore and use classification keys to help group, identify and name a variety of living things in their local and wider environment. They will recognise that environments can change and that this can sometimes pose dangers to living things. They will learn about the effects that deforestation has on food chains.

Music

Children will be exploring music through a range of genres and instrumental



families. They will be having a weekly music lesson that will focus on tempo, dynamics, crescendo and diminuendo. They will also be showing appreciation of musical styles and genres through our 'Music of the Day'

PE: Inside Gymnastics

In this unit children will continue to implement and develop a broader range of skills, learning how to use them in different ways and to link them to make actions and sequences of movement. They should enjoy communicating, collaborating and competing with each other.

Outdoor: Invasion games- tag rugby

Children will learn about Keeping possession, marking & tackling, Controlling receiving. They will learn a wider range of techniques and how to plan tactics as a team, They will learn how to evaluate their own and others' performances, and how to identify a focus for improvement.

PHSE: Celebrating Differences



This term the children will be looking at celebrating differences. They will discuss and understand making assumptions, bullying and how people can be influenced. Children will also be identifying what makes them special and unique.

DT: 2D shapes to 3D products

In DT this term, the children will investigate and evaluate existing products, design, make and evaluate their own product against their design brief and criteria. The children will look at a range of textile products that have a selection of stitches, joins, fabrics, finishing techniques and fastenings.

Computing: Audio Editing



Children will be using an audio software to create a podcast about the Living things and their habitat. They will record, review, edit and share their work.
