Communication and Language:

The children will be listening to a variety of texts about under the sea and responding to questions showing their understanding. They will be observing coastal images, learning new words to describe what they can see, hear, smell, feel and touch. We will be using a variety of props and objects from the coastal regions like; shells, rocks, pebbles, sand etc.



Personal, Social Emotional Development

This term we will be talking about emotions and how the children are

the children are feeling about moving to year 1, having a new classroom and new teachers. We will also be discussing 'our body' specifically, how they have changed since being a baby. We will also be focussing on 'fears' and 'fun'; children will share how they are feeling and what is on their mind during this transition period.

Physical Development

The children will be taking part in Athletics this term. Performing fundamental movements such as: jumping, over arm throwing, under arm throwing skipping, hopping, running, climbing in preparation for Sports Day.



Literacy

This term we will be reading a variety of under the sea books like 'Sharing a shell', 'commotion in the Ocean' and during Dialogic book talk a 'National Geographic Kids: Ocean Find it!'
