Communication and Language

This half term the Children will be encouraged to offer explanations for why things might happen, making use of recently introduced vocabulary from stories, non-fiction, rhymes and poems learnt from the 'My World' Topic. They will also be focusing on extending their ability to listen attentively and respond to what they hear with relevant questions, comments and actions when being read to and during whole class discussions and small group interactions.

This half term the children will be talking about their emotions and how they are feeling about moving to year 1, having a new classroom and new teachers. They will be thinking about the fun they have had in Reception and their fears about moving into year 1.

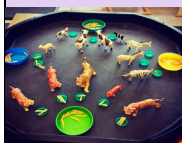
Literacy

This half term the focus texts will be based on the topic of looking after our world. We will be looking at fiction and non-fiction texts to help support learning. The children will also talk about people who are a force for positive change in helping to preserve our world. They will also discuss how they personally can make a difference by not littering and saving water. The focus texts are 'Somebody Swallowed Stanley', Omar, the Bees and Me and Our First heroes - Eco Warriors.



Maths

This half term in maths this term, the children will be consolidating their learning of number bonds to 5 and recalling them quickly. They will also be learning some number bonds to 10. The children will learn how to double and halve numbers and to share equally in groups.

Understanding the World
