Communication and Language

This term in Nursery we will be learning nursery rhymes such as, 'Old Mac Donald had a Farm' and 'Miss Polly had a Dolly.' During discussions we will be making sense of the world around us by asking questions, sharing ideas, and listening to others.



Personal, Social-Emotional Development

For this half term we will be looking at the topic 'Healthy Me.' We will be learning about foods that are healthy and not so healthy. The children will decide which foods are healthy and which foods are less healthy and sort into groups. We will focus on why sleep is good for your body and discuss the clothing we wear and the things we like doing before going to bed. Children will learn about the importance of washing your hands thoroughly.




Physical Development

Our focus will be developing the children's fine motor skills so that they can use a range of tools competently, confidently, and safely. We will be developing their spatial awareness through a range of outdoor game and performing a sequence of movements to music while participating in a scarf dance.




Literacy

We will start off the term by reading 'Farmer Duck.' We will also read the book 'People Who Help Us' and learn about the jobs of people in our community. We will understand newly introduced vocabulary, and they will develop phonological awareness that includes rhythm and repeated phrases. We will retell the story using a story map using the starters One day... Next ...In the end...



Maths

In Maths this term, we will be learning about the new topic of 'Measures.' We will compare the length of different of objects and can use 2D shapes to create pictures. We will sing and perform number songs such as 'Five Little Firefighters.' In Maths, we will be recognising and sequencing numbers from 1-5. Children will subitise numbers from 1-3 and count forwards and backwards from 1-10.



Expressive Art and Design

This term we will be getting creative with household recycling! We will assemble and join materials making emergency transport out of junk modelling. In music, we will sing new songs linked to our learning journey his term and perform actions and play a music instrument on cue.



Understanding the World

Linking to our learning journey about 'People Who help Us' we will learn about the life and work of Mary Seacole during the Crimean War and compare similarities and differences between nursing in the past and present day. We will talk about the jobs of the people who help us within the community and continue to extend our vocabulary when describing the weather and the seasons. The children will be exploring the natural environment around them, making observations, and drawing pictures of plants and animals.
