
Maths

This half term in maths we will be looking at identifying and representing numbers to 50. Using the language of equal, more than, less than and most. We will be looking at different maths concepts solving problems involving addition and subtraction, and multiplication and division. We will be following the mathematical process of build it, draw it, write it and say it.



English

Children will be exploring the text 'The Extraordinary Gardener'. They will write a simple narrative using a five-sentence story structure. Children will write an explanation text about plants using their knowledge across the curriculum. Through guided reading and phonics sessions (Read, Write, Inc), they will continue to develop their phonic skills.



RE: Sanatana Dharma (Hinduism)

This term the children will be learning about Sanatani beliefs, including Brahman as the one supreme deity present in everything, and the Trimurti—Brahma (creator), Vishnu (preserver), and Shiva (destroyer). They will understand that Hindus believe in one God with many forms and the importance of showing respect to all living things.



Science: Plants

This term in Science we will be learning about plants. We will be developing the skills of observing and recording over time plants and trees. We will be learning the different parts of a plant and making our own labels.



PHSE: Healthy Me

This unit in PSHE, we will be learning about 'Healthy Me'. We will be discussing, what a healthy and unhealthy choice looks like, talking about germs, illness and medicines and how they can help us when we feel sick. We will also be looking at road safety and how to cross the road safely.



Physical Education

Indoor: This term in indoor PE, the children will be learning agility, balance, and coordination through circuits and activities that help them develop control and confidence in movement.

Outdoors: This term in PE, the children will be learning to throw a beanbag underarm, stop a ball with their hands, and roll a ball accurately. They will practise these skills in team games and simple competitions to build control, confidence, and teamwork.



DT – Freestanding structures

This term in DT, the children will be creating a photo frame for a school display. They will design their frame, select suitable materials, make it carefully, and evaluate how it looks and works.



Music This term, the children are learning a range of spring songs. They are developing their singing skills by singing together as an ensemble, exploring different styles, and building confidence performing in front of an audience. The children are also listening to and talking about music, and learning songs in both English and Welsh, ready to perform a small repertoire of songs

Spanish:

The children will be learning to name animals, describe their colours, and use more adjectives. They will also act out a Spanish storybook to practise their new words.



Computing: Technology around us



This term the children will be familiarising themselves with word processors. They will learn how to use the keyboard to form words. They will learn how to edit their fonts and change the look of their work.
