
Maths



In Maths this term, the children will be revising their knowledge and skills of fractions, decimals, and percentages,

including multiplying and dividing fractions. We will look at 2D and 3D shapes as well as identifying, measuring and drawing angles. The children will also revise their knowledge of statistics and measurements.

English



In English this term the children will be using the book 'Pig-Heart Boy' by Marjorie Blackman as their core text for reading and their stimulus for writing. They will answer a variety of comprehension questions about the events, characters and mood of the story. They will be writing their own dilemma story as well as writing a balanced argument about whether organ donation should be compulsory.

Science: Animals Including Humans



In this unit, the children will learn about the Circulatory system as well as the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle. They will also learn about the bodily journey of nutrients and water.

Music



This term, the children will be using keyboards to identify notes of different note durations. They will learn to read different musical notations and build up to playing a 3, 4 and 5 note piece.

Physical Education



Outdoor: Striking and Fielding Games (Cricket)

In this unit, children will practice and improve their batting, bowling and fielding skills. Through games, they will learn when to attack and when to defend. Lessons will build on previous learning to help children develop confidence, skills and a clear understanding of the game.

Indoor: Boccia

This term, pupils will develop tactical thinking in Boccia by creating and using attacking and defensive tactics, and by applying the rules to officiate games fairly.

Spanish



This term, children will review days of the week and places in a town, extend time expressions using

menos, and learn to make arrangements including place and time. They will also learn to recognise the weather and develop related conversation skills.

PHSE: Healthy Me



This term, pupils will learn how substances affect the body and how to care for their wellbeing. They will explore exploitation, including county lines and gang culture, as well as mental health and stress management.



P4C

This term, children will be introduced to Philosophy for Children through guided discussions using different stimuli to explore whether animal testing is fair, who decides what is right, and whether alternatives should be found.



This term, children will take part in additional revision sessions for reading and maths. Using gap analysis from assessments and class learning, they will complete tailored tasks on SATs Companion and receive extra small group or whole class input.
